Although we like to think we are "post Covid" and the days of my newsletter indicating "unprecedented times" and possible classes/year levels being sent home, this current wave of virus and flu seems to be even more debilitating or recurring, impacting many of our staff (or their families). While we are fortunate in that we have a loyal and regular group of supportive relievers, the demand this term has been excessive. Adding to this complexity is that the external relief supply pool is also experiencing over-demand as there is a finite number of relievers on the North Shore. We have cancelled any support classes, had any non contact teachers in class, cancelled all teacher release, but despite all these efforts in the last two weeks once again we have regularly had to split 2-3 classes daily. Thank you to you and your children for your understanding and support.

In the next month there are a number of out of school class trips or events, which you have or will be receiving a parent consent notice to sign, eg Year 2 trip to Clip N' Climb next Thursday (28th November), Year 0/1 and 5/6 Zoo trip on 9th December. We cannot take children out of schools grounds unless we have your signed permission so it is vital that you return these forms as soon as possible so that teachers can progress organisation, including parent support numbers or the required staffing ratios. Thanks in advance to those parents who are able to take leave from work to support these events, as without your help and attendance we would not be able to provide these exciting end of year opportunities.

As advised to relevant parents, the Year 5/6 end of year celebration has now been confirmed for Monday 16th December, 6.00pm-8.00pm at Northcross Intermediate School Hall. Due to safety requirements there are restricted audience numbers so a letter will be sent home tomorrow where you can request either one or two tickets to attend.
